### BDBD NEWS

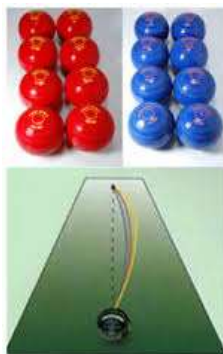
It's time to vote on the suggested changes to the rules of play for the Outdoor season, 2017/18

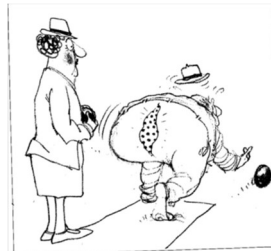
