- **\$14 000** – Look Good Feel Good Wellness Centre, Ballarat.

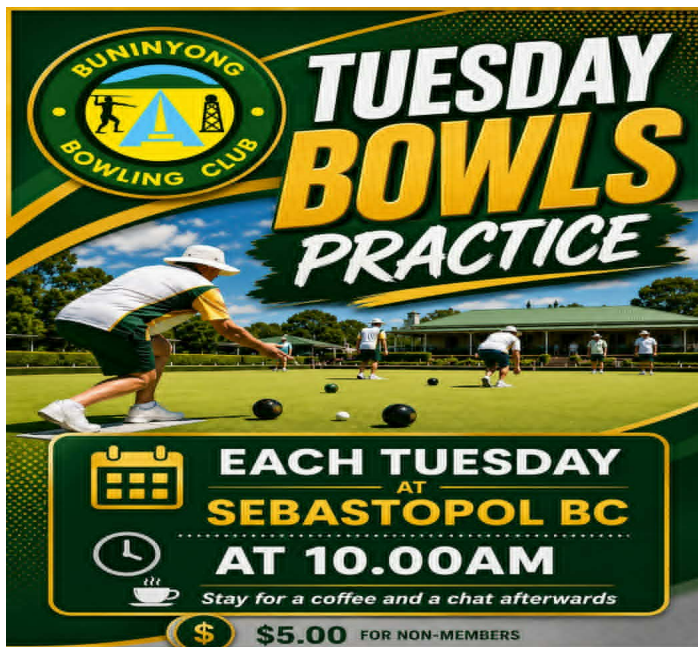
Women in Bowls Committee

The Gold Diggers battled it out against [West Coast Wizards U/18 Squad](#), [Northern Flyers U/18 Bowls Squad](#) and the newly named [Geelong Vipers U18 Bowls](#) in their fantastic new uniforms. The exciting format showcased the skills of almost 60 of our state's up and coming juniors over 6 x 45 minute games of 2 bowl triples. The scoring system is based on pennant with winners receiving 10 points, plus 2 points per rink win and 1 point for a draw.

It was evident from the first round that the standard was going to be high and results exciting, with two close matches being played out. The Diggers narrowly lost to the Vipers by 5 shots and only collected one rink win.

Our squad made up of Billie, Boyd, Charlie, Charlotte, Connor, Jack B, Jack L, Jaxon, Jaxyn, Jay, Logan, Micah, Mikayla and Yuvi reset and went on to win the next three rounds, only dropping two rinks.

After a short break for dinner, the juniors returned to the green, where the Diggers banked a solid win over the Wizards, with all rinks registering wins.

The final game saw a rematch with the Vipers and this showdown would decide the winner of the Great Southern Shield.

The atmosphere was electric across the full 45 minutes, with the voices of players, spectators and coaches echoing and bouncing off the magnificent OG dome. With scoring close, the tension mounted and the standard lifted to another level.

The pivotal moment came when across all four rinks, the Diggers were down on every head. One after the other, all four skippers - Micah, Jack L, Connor and Jack B - played brilliant conversion shots that turned the end in the Digger's favour. This helped to build the momentum required to get our team over the line.

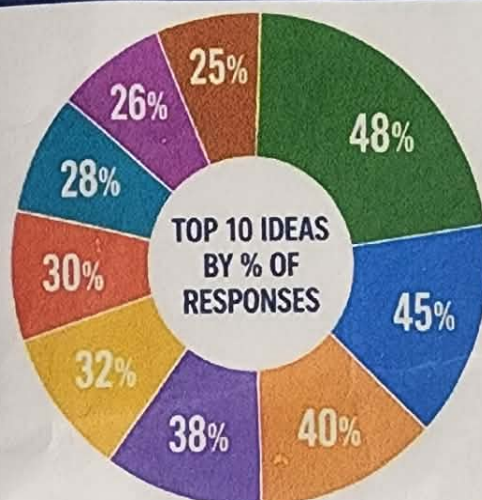

Rob will be joining Elaine Pitts as the Ladies Champion to go on and compete in the Champion of Champions tournament.

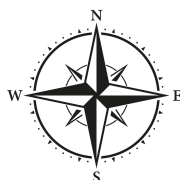
Pennant Signup Sheets

CHANGES BEING MADE TO “B GREEN” – BY SCOTTY ROBERTS

Some members may have noticed recent works taking place along the ditch on the dome side of B Green. Earlier this year, when B Green was converted to Tift Dwarf, a different irrigation setup was required to support the high water needs during establishment.

That ditch already contained three existing runs of pipe, which made installing the final line extremely tight—especially with upright connectors every six metres. A few of those connectors ended up sitting too high, which would interfere with bowls entering the ditch.

To fix this properly, we’re widening the ditch by 110 mm and installing a metal plinth. This will give us enough space to bury the new pipe safely and ensure the ditch is clear for bowls.

The job has turned out to be a bit more involved than first expected, but once completed, the ditch will hopefully be fully compliant and trouble-free for play.

NEW LOCKERS FOR THE CHANGE ROOMS

The Board agreed to commission Geoff Worsley to build some new larger lockers in the Mens’ Changeroom. These lockers will enable bowlers to put their whole bowls bags into these lockers.

The exact timeframe for these lockers being completed is unknown as it’s a large job. We will provide an update in the next newsletter.
